Ruby-red. Begins with a light menthol note, then opens to show woodsy underbrush and very ripe-almost overripe-red fruit. There's less of the almost cooked character on the palate, along with an intriguing peppery quality. Sweet and soft, but turns a bit dry on the moderately persistent finish. A very well-made wine by owner Pablo Harri, the highly respected winemaker at Col d'Orcia.
